- Sponsor: Federal Highway Administration
- Eligibility and Requirement:
 - Native American Students pursuing a degree (Bachelor, Master, and Doctorate) in a full-time program in a transportation-related discipline.
 - Conduct ongoing research in one or more transportation-related disciplines
- Annual Application Time Frame: February 01 to March 21 (may vary)
- Review: Due by March 31 (May vary)
- Notification: mid May to mid June (may Vary)
- Award: Up to 10,000 including 1,500 travel expenses to Washington DC for presentation.
