

Framework for Tribal Partnerships

1. Steering Committee (Quarterly meetings)
 - a. Members - Key executives from each agency
 - b. Duties
 - i. Steer the partnership
 - ii. Determine purpose & members for subgroups
 - iii. Monitor subgroups progress – hold them accountable to complete work product – both as a steering committee member and as individual leaders within each agency
 - iv. Share Subgroups progress with Partnership Members

2. Subgroups (Task Teams)
 - a. Members - from each agency as appointed by steering committee
 - b. Duties
 - i. Determine leader or co leaders
 1. Report to the Steering Committee
 - ii. Meet on a regular schedule and actively participate
 - iii. Keep accurate notes and Action Plan
 - iv. Set goals
 - v. Meet goals
 - vi. Implement changes

3. Partnership Members (Annual meeting)
 - a. Bring ideas, issues and successes to the steering committee for action.
 - b. Actively participate in Subgroups when asked.
 - c. Work together to enhance the partnership by communicating between agencies and with the steering committee.
