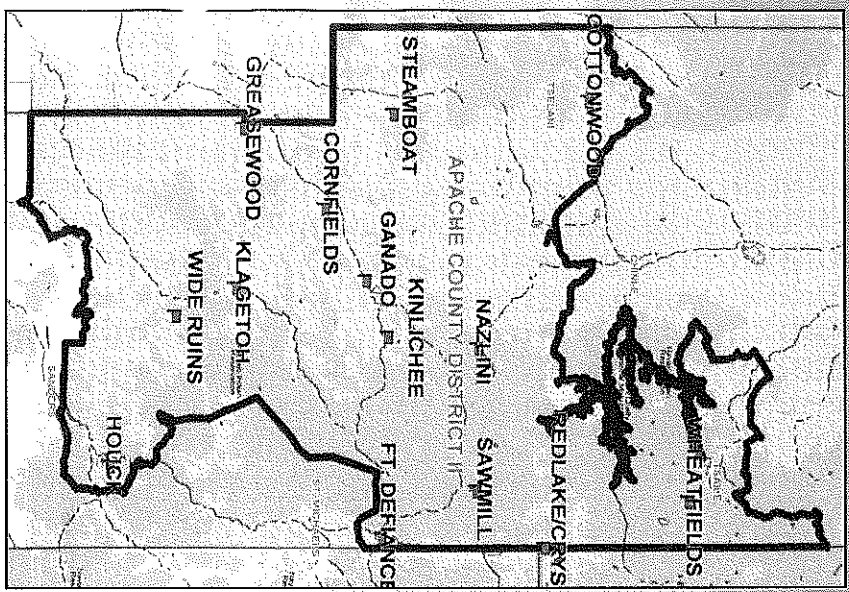


SERVICE AREA



According to policy and procedures of the Arizona Revised Statutes (ARS), the first Intergovernmental Agreement of 1982 between the Navajo Nation, Apache County and the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) established county district offices for District I in Chinle, District II in Ganado and District III in St. Johns. All three district offices maintain approximately 871 miles of unpaved school bus routes within the Navajo Nation.

The District II Offices maintain approximately 372.8 miles within the following chapters: Tsale-Wheatfields, Sawmill, Fort Defiance, Red Lake /Crystal, Kindahlchee, Tselani Cottonwood, Steamboat, Lower Greasewood, Klagetoh, Wide Ruins, Houck, Nazhni, Ganado and Cornfields.

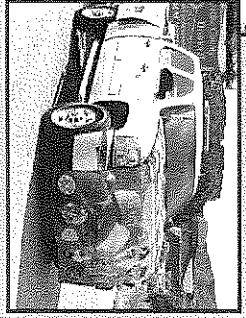
The Apache County staff promotes progress through commitment and accountability following the provisions of the Arizona Revised Statutes, (ARS).
