SCAT does not have a 911 system, making it difficult for emergency vehicles to locate homes and other buildings. The adoption of a modern 911 system would enhance the effectiveness of emergency services. It would also document the tribe's "centerline" road miles, which may increase the potential for increased transportation funding.
