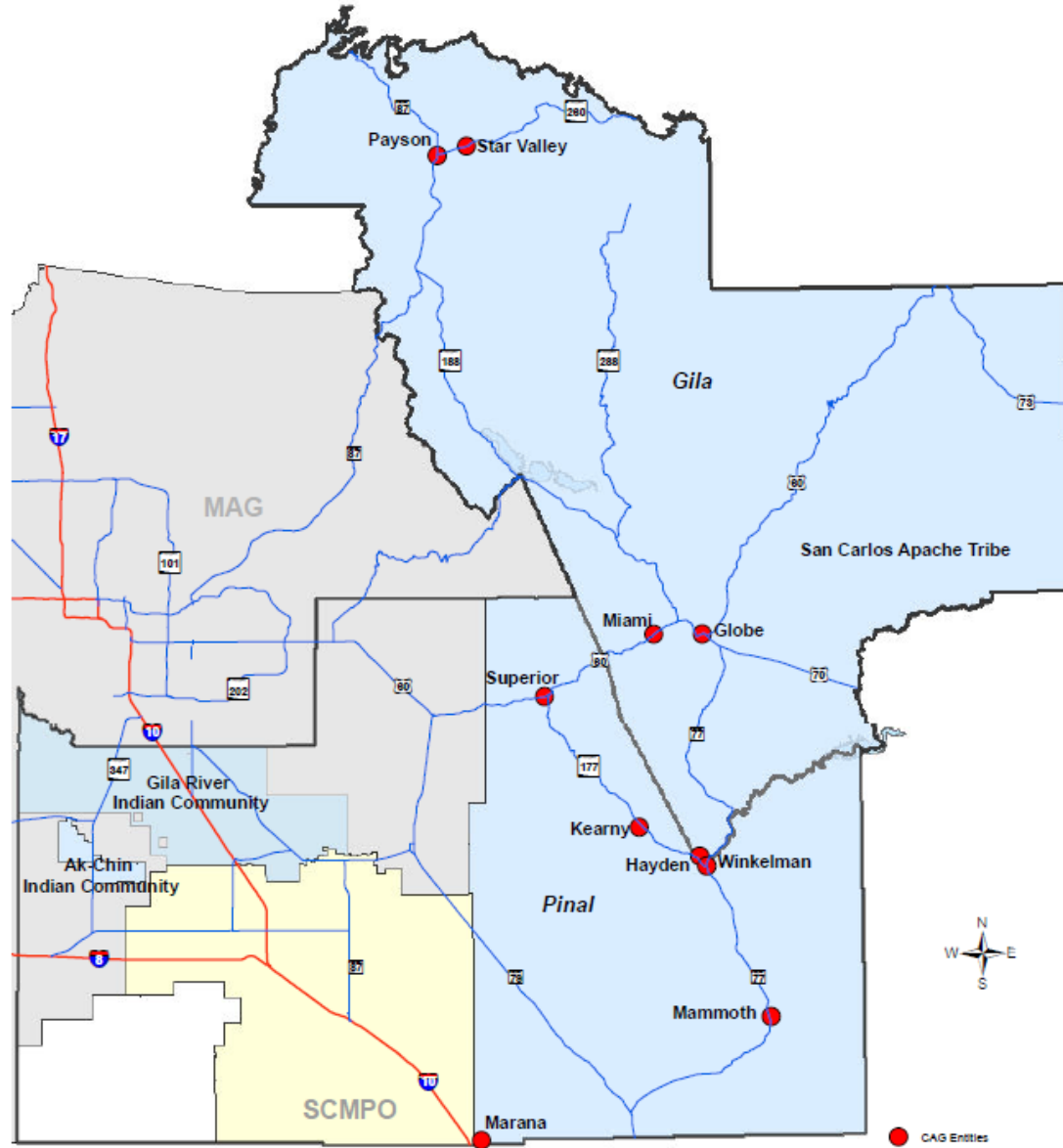

- Issued RFP on August 1<sup>st</sup>
- Selection Committee: ADOT, Apache Junction, Gila County, Payson, Pinal County, and CAG
